Thoughtful decisions were made, always with the mission in mind: YWCA Northeast Indiana is dedicated to eliminating racism, empowering women and promoting peace, justice, freedom, and dignity for all.

It was a banner year for our Circle of Women event held in December with over 600 women and men in attendance and the location was moved to the Grand Wayne Center to accommodate the larger audience. Circle is not only our largest fundraiser, but a great opportunity to speak to a large audience about the mission and offer a program that is truly unique to domestic violence prevention programming.

Education Services

We provide education for teens to prevent dating violence and future domestic violence (DV), and training for adults.

3,842 teens educated

- **Eyes Wide Open:** Identifying healthy and unhealthy relationships
- **Digital Boundaries:** Exploring dangers of inappropriate social media, sexting, and cyber-bullying
- **Don't Be a Digital Bully:** Recognizing bullying in its digital forms

347 adults trained

- **Domestic Violence 101:** Recognizing signs of DV and ways to help victims
- **Domestic Violence 101 With Children:** an in-depth look at how DV affects children
- **Digital Boundaries:** Showing parents the threats technology poses to teens
- Customized programs for the workplace, salons, churches, health care professionals, social service agencies, and community groups.

Community Awareness

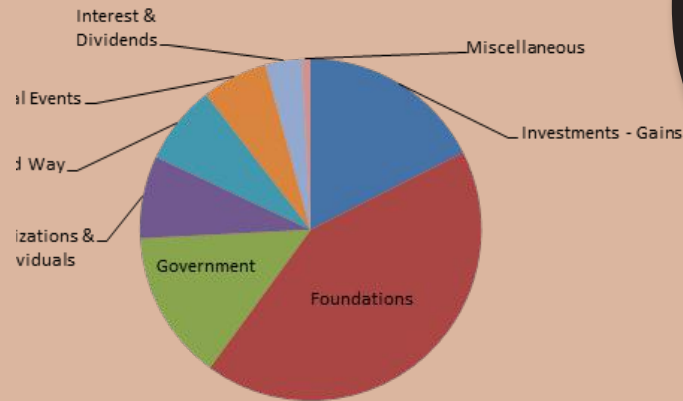
YWCA Northeast Indiana staff and volunteers join in various community safety events to reach children and families in need, and provide them with life-saving education.

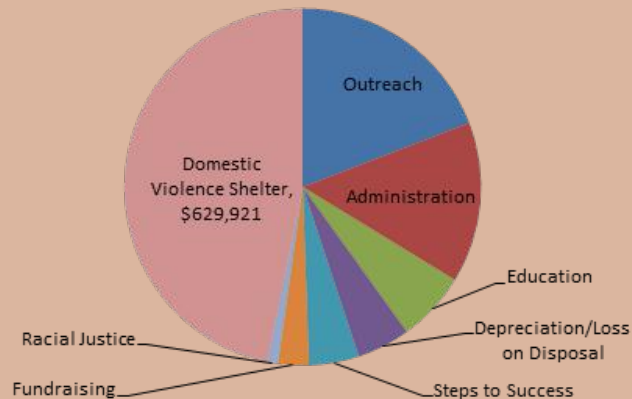
