ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

ADDICTION & RECOVERY 101

CYBERSENSE 201

Guides students (grades 7-8) in making informed decisions about online privacy, evaluating trustworthy information, and setting healthy boundaries with technology.

Teaches teens and young adults (grades 8-12) to recognize the warning signs of unhealthy relationships—and identify healthy relationship behaviors.
