SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS RECEIVE:

- Financial support for tuition, books, rent, utilities & childcare
- An Empowerment Advocate to assist them through their academic journey

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Resident of Northeast Indiana
- Has been removed from the abusive situation for at least 6 months
- Open to participating in services from YWCA Northeast Indiana
- Income level is less than 200% of poverty level
- Desire to enroll in a state-accredited university or union-certified apprenticeship program
