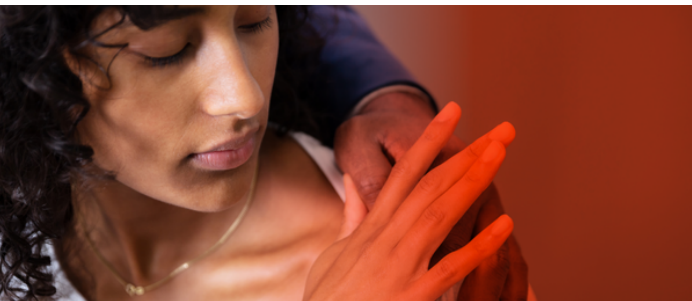

Sexual violence knows no boundaries.

WHAT IS SEXUAL VIOLENCE?

An abuser may...

- insist on unwanted kissing or touching
- perform unwanted rough or violent sexual activity
- rape or attempt to rape
- refuse to use condoms or restrict someone's access to birth control
- keep someone from protecting themselves from sexually transmitted infections (STIs).
- have sexual contact with someone who is very drunk, drugged, unconscious, or otherwise unable to give a clear and informed "yes" or "no"
- threaten or pressure someone into unwanted sexual activity

- Incest and/or rape survivors
- Survivors of childhood sexual abuse and molestation
- Those currently experiencing sexual abuse, assault, or rape
- Those experiencing sexual harassment
